

If you are interested in joining GSAR, please know that all new recruits must attend and complete the Support Academy in the fall with the option of continuing on to Field Academy in the winter. You can submit an application at any time, however, please note that you will hear back with more information about the next Academy in mid- to late-summer.

Skagit GSAR is a non-profit (501c.3) organization, and operates on donations. To cover some of the costs involved in the Academy, a one-time, non-refundable \$50 fee (discounted to \$25 for ages under 18 and over 60) is charged to new members upon beginning the Academy. This covers everything from office supplies to a T-shirt given to graduates.
